
Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the west side of 6th Street between L Street and M Street has parallel parking on The United House of Prayer along with the Advisory Neighborhood Commission has determined additional parking capacity is needed on Sunday to accommodate parishioners. They propose installing BACK-IN ANGLE PARKING on Sundays between 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM west side of 6th Street, N.W.

An on-site investigation has revealed that extending the hour of ANGLE PARKING would have little impact on overall traffic circulation, and would cause minimal inconvenience for local residents. Therefore, we recommend that BACK-IN ANGLE PARKING be installed along the west side of 6th Street, N.W., from L Street to M Street Sundays from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.


